NORTHERN MICHIGAN D/B/A MICHIGAN HEART & VASCULAR SPECIALISTS,
NRC LICENSE NO. 21-32345-01**

Dear Michelle L. Kritzman:

In letter dated November 23, 2022, McLaren Northern Michigan notified the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of a request to terminate NRC Materials License No. 21-32345-01. Specifically, McLaren Northern Michigan requested to transfer the control of its facility located at 560 W Mitchell St., Petoskey, Michigan, 49770 to NRC Materials License No. 21-16732-01. Your letter is available electronically from the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML22332A431 (non-public).

McLaren Northern Michigan submitted information sufficient to permit the transfer of the only one location of use listed in NRC License No. 21-32345-01 to NRC License No. 21-16732-01. Based on its review, the NRC staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material at 560 W Mitchell St., Petoskey, Michigan, 49770 has been transferred from McLaren Northern Michigan d/b/a Michigan Heart & Vascular Specialists, NRC License No. 21-32345-01, to McLaren Northern Michigan, NRC License No. 21-16732-01.

Based on this conclusion, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC-regulated material are required on the part of McLaren Northern Michigan d/b/a Michigan Heart & Vascular Specialists. The NRC understands that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the 560 W Mitchell St., Petoskey, Michigan, 49770 facility have been transferred to and will be maintained by McLaren Northern Michigan, NRC License No. 21-16732-01.

Accordingly, NRC License No. 21-32345-01 is hereby terminated. A copy of the amended license—Amendment No. 22—is enclosed.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required because this action is categorically excluded under Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) Section 51.22(c).
