On July 15, 2019, you submitted a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, seeking any and all orders issued by the NRC, or any of its affiliated agencies, other administrative or disciplinary actions taken by NRC, records of investigations for violations of federal law and regulations, and records relevant to misconduct, in regards to and/or against Foss Therapy Services, Inc. and/or a named individual.

By an email dated March 6, 2023, Sam Dixon of our office sent you a "still interested" inquiry with respect to your request, asking that we hear from you by April 5, 2023. Our inquiry also informed you that we would administratively close your request if we did not hear from you by that date. When your request was reassigned to Denisha Gilet upon Sam's departure, we followed up with you because we did not see any documentation in our records of any response from you. By an email dated May 2, 2023, Denisha sent a second "still interested" inquiry with respect to your FOIA request. In our email, we asked for you to respond to us by May 9, 2023. This May 2nd email also informed you that we would administratively close our file on your request if we did not hear from you. As it is now one month later, and we still have heard nothing from you, we have construed your silence to mean that you are no longer interesting in pursuing this matter at this time. Accordingly, we are closing our file on your request.
