Dear Erik Olson:

Thank you for the information. We reviewed the application with supporting information. Based on the review, we will need the following.

1. Your current license is authorized for one Thermo Fisher Scientific Model 5200; however, your renewal application did not include this type of gauges. Based on a review of our record, it appeared that your Model 5200 gauge was replaced with a Model 5201 gauge by a manufacturer. If you would like to remove it from your license, provide a copy of the transferring receipt to confirm that an authorized licensee had the possession of your licensed material and a copy of the last leak test.
2. For "Routine Maintenance" in Section 10.8, provide the following statement: "We will implement and maintain procedures for routine maintenance of our gauges according to each manufacturer's or distributor's written recommendations and instructions."
3. Provide the sealed source's manufacturer and model and the maximum number of gauges which you would like to possess.
4. Based on our policy to renewing a materials license in its entirety, please provide a copy of the delegation of authority for the Radiation Safety Officer for our record.

To continue the review of your application, we request that you submit your response under a dated and signed cover letter by April 13, 2023. In the cover letter, please reference the license number and Mail Control No. 634189. We will assume that you do not wish to further pursue this licensing action if we do not receive a reply within the specified timeframe noted above.
