INFORMATION, MAIL CONTROL NO. 635647**

Dear Belinda Toro:

This is in reference to your letter dated May 17, 2023, requesting to requesting approval for a transfer of control of Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) License No. 52-25531-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Please clarify if the transaction subject to this amendment has already closed or whether it is yet pending NRC approval. In an e-mail to the NRC dated May 18, 2023, you had described the change-of-control of the license as anticipated for closure on May 31, 2023. As a reminder, Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 30.34(b)(1) requires, in part, that: "*no license issued or granted pursuant to 10 CFR Part 30 and 35 shall be transferred, assigned, or in any manner disposed of through transfer of control unless the Commission shall find the transfer is in accordance with the provisions of the Atomic Energy Act and shall give its consent in writing.*"
2. Please clarify the other party or parties to the change of control. The first paragraph of the letter dated May 17, 2023, describes an involved party in the indirect transfer of control as "Orlando Health Puerto Rico, LLC" or "OHPR." In contrast, the provided radioactive materials license from the State of Florida was listed as "Orlando Health, Inc. dba Orlando Regional Medical Center."
3. In addition and as applicable to your answer to Item No. 2 above, please describe the relationship between Orlando Health Puerto Rico, LLC and Orlando Health, Inc. d/b/a Orlando Regional Medical Center (e.g. does Orlando Health, Inc. own Orlando Regional Medical Center and Orlando Health Puerto, LLC?).
4. Please provide a signed letter describing the transferee (identified in Item 2 above) as consenting to the transaction described in your letter dated May 17, 2023, and that the transferee agrees with and will abide by the details and commitments contained therein. Alternatively, you may confirm that you hold a senior management position with the transferee indicated in Item 2. If so, please indicate your title.

While it is allowable, please refrain from submitting proprietary information in support of a license unless necessary. Keep in mind that all NRC licenses are considered to be in the public domain, and therefore may be viewed by any member of the public who requests to see them.
