Re: Response to the Additional Information Needed for the Amendment Request for Exempt Distribution License No. 20-00320-14E, Your email dated June 23, 2023

Ms. Cox:

As stated in my email to Shirley Xu dated June 13, 2023, PerkinElmer, Incorporated recently changed its name to Revvity, Incorporated and I requested that the licensee listed in section 1 of license no. 20-00320-14E be changed to reflect this change. You responded to my email in an email dated June 23, 2023. In your email, you requested my response to three questions. I am going to repeat each question below in italics followed by my response.

- *Does the name change include any elements of "change of control?"*

Response: The name change does not include any elements of "change of control". This response is based on the elements listed in section 5 of NUREG-1556, Volume 15.

- *Is the company changing the name with no other changes to items on the license, and no changes in control or ownership is occurring?*

Response: Yes, that is correct. There are no other changes to items on the license and no changes in control or ownership.


- *Is the ownership changing, but all items on the license are to remain the same?*

Response: No, the ownership is not changing. PerkinElmer, Inc. recently sold a portion of the corporation. The entity that purchased the portion of the corporation also purchased the name PerkinElmer, Inc. The name of the part of the company that was not sold has been renamed Revvity, Inc.

In addition to the name change, my original email requested that the Tri-Carb LSC 3180XX be deleted from section 9.B. of the license. That was a mistake on my part. Please disregard this request. That instrument was deleted from the license in the current amendment number 24 dated February 15, 2023.
