Good afternoon, Mr. Hoey,

This email is in response to your letter dated June 13, 2023, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requesting an amendment to License No. 20-00320-14E. We need additional information to complete the request. Perkin Elmer requested the name of the company change to Revvity. Provide information on the questions below.

- Does the name change include any elements of “change of control?”
- Is the company changing the name with no other changes to items on the license, and no changes in control or ownership is occurring?
- Is the ownership changing, but all items on the license are to remain the same?

Also, Perkin Elmer requested to delete the Tri-Carb LSC 3180XX instrument from the license in section 9.B. On the license, the authorization use section 9.B. states, “In accordance with 10 CFR 32.14, the licensee is authorized to distribute ionizing radiation measuring instruments Quantulus GCT A6229XX series, containing Ba-133 for purposes of internal calibration or standardization, not greater than 1 microcurie per instrument, to persons who are exempt from the requirements under 10 CFR 30.15(a)(9), or equivalent regulations of any Agreement State.” Section 9.B. does not reference the Tri-Carb LSC 3180XX instrument. What information should be deleted from the license?
