Comply with the provisions of Title A, Department Regulation 61-63

1) License Condition: The licensee shall comply with the provisions of Title A, Department Regulation 61-63; [enter part number(s) and name(s)].

Justification: Department Regulation 61-63, Title A, is comprised of 12 separate Parts. This condition identifies the specific applicable parts of Department Regulation 61-63, Title A to each licensee. This condition will differ based on the modality for which the licensee is authorized.

Limit possession limits below Category 1 and Category 2 thresholds

2) In addition to the possession limits in item [enter item number], the licensee shall further restrict the possession of licensed material to quantities below the limits specified in Appendix A-Category 1 and Category 2 Radioactive Materials, Part XII, Department Regulation 61-63.

Justification: This condition restricts the possession of licensed material to quantities below the Category 1 and Category 2 thresholds. This condition would be used if a overall possession limits could exceed Category 1 and Category 2 thresholds, however, the licensee will not actually possess aggregated quantities of radioactive material above Category 1 and Category 2 thresholds.

Location of Use and Temporary Job Sites

3) Licensed material shall be used or stored at the licensee's facilities located at [enter licensed address] and may be used at temporary jobsites of the licensee anywhere in South Carolina, where the Department maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed materials, excluding areas of exclusive Federal jurisdiction. This condition does not prohibit use in other Agreement States or in U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission jurisdiction under reciprocity procedures which may be established by those States or the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

Justification: This condition outlines the licensed location of use and allows for temporary job sites in other Agreement States and U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission jurisdictions under reciprocity.
