New Licensee Name: McKenna, Sunabe, & Associates, LLC Doing business as Engineering & Inspections Hawaii

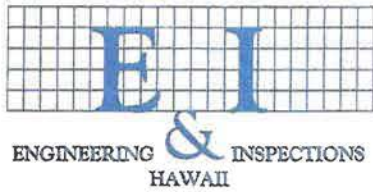
