I am a pediatric oncologist and physician=scientist who has been a leader in the development of 131I-MIBG therapy for children with neuroblastoma.

Implementation of these new guidelines would put our young patients at significant risk due to prolonged times required for sedation and Foley catheter placement.

I strongly recommend that you seek more data from the pediatric oncology community and consider either not implementing this change or making exceptions for pediatric patients.
