This acknowledges receipt of your letter dated August 23, 2023, reporting a potential medical event that occurred on August 8, 2023. The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has reviewed your letter, in which you provided a description of the event and your assessment of a possible cause; the effect, if any, on the individual who received the administration; the actions taken or planned to prevent recurrence; and certification that the individual who received the administration has been notified. The NRC has no further questions regarding your report at this time and will continue our review of this matter as part of the ongoing inspection of your radiation protection program.
