Dear Mr. Greubel:

This letter is regarding the request dated August 11, 2023, to terminate your U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Materials License No. 48-15031-01.

The U.S. NRC's guidance document for your proposed type of license is NUREG-1556, Volume 4, Rev. 1, dated July 2016, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses, Program-Specific Guidance About Fixed Gauge Licenses." This guidance is available on the U.S. NRC website at: <https://www.nrc.gov/docs/ML1618/ML16188A048.pdf>

Upon review of the request, I identified the following areas requiring additional or clarifying information:

1. [Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations \(10 CFR\) §30.51\(a\)](#), requires that you retain records of the receipt, transfer and disposal of licensed radioactive materials.

Your request included documentation of the transfer for disposal of the following Thermo Fisher Scientific (formerly Thermo MeasureTech) fixed gauging devices:

- Thermo Fisher Scientific Model 5200, Device S/N B2966
- Thermo Fisher Scientific Model 5200, Device S/N B2965
- Thermo Fisher Scientific Model 5200, Device S/N B3494
- Thermo Fisher Scientific Model 5202, Device S/N B3530

Your license also authorized possession and use of Thermo Process Instruments, LP (formerly Thermo MeasureTech, TN Technologies) Model 5203 source housings and Thermo Fisher Scientific (formerly TN Technologies, Texas Nucler Corp.) Model 5038 and 5038A belt weigh scale gauges.

Clarify the status of all licensed fixed gauging devices previously used or stored at your licensed facility. As applicable, include all applicable records of transfer and/or disposal and associated leak test reports.

2. In accordance with [10 CFR §30.35\(g\)](#), describe any incidents involving ruptured, leaking or lost sealed sources or fixed gauging devices along with any other incidents involving radioactive materials at your licensed facility in Tell City, Indiana.

In accordance with [10 CFR §2.390](#) of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC website at <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.

To continue review of your request, please submit your response to this letter within 15 calendar days from the date of this letter. In your response, please refer to the license, docket, and control number specified below. I will assume that you do not wish to further pursue this licensing action if I do not receive a reply within the specified timeframe noted above.
