The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Office of Investigations (OI) has closed the subject case regarding a former contractor employee who alleged being discriminated by management for raising nuclear safety concerns at Vogtle Units 3 & 4 facility in Waynesboro, GA.

The NRC has determined that there was insufficient evidence to substantiate the allegation that an employee was retaliated against by management for raising nuclear safety concerns.
