In NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials," dated August 11, 2023, and your letter dated August 31, 2023, you requested termination of your U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Materials License No. 48-15031-01. Your requests are available electronically from the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession Nos. ML23233A024 and ML23249A233.

During the course of my review of your requests, I identified that you are in possession of two Ohmart/VEGA Model SH-F1, S/N 6652GK and 19399GK, fixed gauging devices that are subject to registration in accordance with <u>Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR)</u> 31.5(c)(13). Your requests identified that all specifically licensed devices acquired under the authority of this license have been accounted for and appropriately transferred. Documentation of the transfer/disposal of radioactive materials, including associated leak test reports were reviewed.

Based on this review, it appears that all specifically licensed devices have been removed from your facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current U.S. NRC criteria. Your facility is suitable for release to unrestricted use, and U.S. NRC Materials License No. 48-15031-01 is hereby terminated.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required because this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR §51.22(c).
