Re: NRC Violations

Dear Elizabeth Tindle-Engelmann:

We have reviewed the violations handed down by the NRC on August 24th, 2023. This letter is intended to show our remediation of the violations for License No. 13-16961-02, Docket No. 030-18173 and are attached.

- A. Violation on review the radiation protection program content and implementation. Materials Inspection & Testing Inc., has implemented a program to be performed annually on the first Tuesday of every March. M.I.T. will develop, document, and preform controls to achieve occupational doses and doses to the general public. We will keep the records for a minimum of three years. On line classes for employees will be mandatory and provided yearly by Qaltek. We have contacted Qaltek to set up a time to review the program, there availability is set for November 2023.
- B. Condition 13.A which is violation for sealed source be tested for leakage on an annual basis. Qaltek has sent eight (8) leak test kits, which four (4) will be used every six months. They will be recorded and saved for at least 3 years.
- C. Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (49 CFR) 71.5(a). M.I.T., Inc., Mr. Tim Reams and Mr. Kent Fingerle has completed the DOT Class 7 Portable gauge transportation coarse on line provided by Qaltek on October 16th 2023. The above-mentioned employees are the only personnel who use the CPN Nuclear gauges.
- D. Reasons for violations. Mr. Tim Reams is the RSO, and is totally responsible for the negligence for these violations. The leak tests used to be provided by Cline's Technical Services, but has since been terminated (out of business) and was not found out until August 24th 2023.

Materials Inspection & Testing has placed the corrective procedures in place and will continue to follow them.
