
Enclosed is a copy of the final revisions to the Virginia Radiation Protection Regulations (12VAC5-481). This revision was published July 17, 2023 in the Virginia Register and became effective on August 16, 2023. The final regulations are identified by line-in/line-out text and correspond to the following equivalent amendments to NRC's regulations.
