

Pursuant to KRS 211.842 et seq., the Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services regulations 902 KAR Chapter 100, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued to receive, acquire, own, possess and transfer radioactive material listed below; and to use such radioactive material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below. This license is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the Cabinet for Health and Family Services, now or hereinafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.

9. Authorized Use
- A. For use in uptake, dilution and excretion studies permitted by 10 CFR 35.100.

10. The licensee shall comply with the provisions of the Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services Administrative Radiation Regulations 902 KAR Chapter 100.
11. Radioactive material shall be used only at the licensee's facilities located at:
240 Hospital Road
Whitesburg, KY 41858
12. Copies of records required pursuant to 902 KAR Chapter 100 or conditions of the license shall be maintained for inspection by the Cabinet at 240 Hospital Road, Whitesburg, KY 41858
13. The radiation safety officer for the activities authorized by this license is Travis Painter, M.S.
14. The licensee may transport radioactive material, or deliver radioactive material to a carrier for transport, in accordance with the provisions of 902 KAR 100:070, and other departments of the Commonwealth of Kentucky having jurisdiction.
15. In addition to the possession limits in Item 8, the licensee shall further restrict the possession of radioactive material to quantities below the minimum limit specified in 902 KAR 100:042, Sections 11, 12, and 13 for establishing decommissioning financial assurance.

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16. This license and the right to possess or utilize radioactive material granted by this license issued under 902 KAR Chapter 100 shall not be transferred, assigned, or otherwise disposed of, through transfer of control of a license to a person unless the Cabinet, after securing full information, finds that the transfer is in accordance with the requirements of 902 KAR Chapter 100 and gives its consent, in writing, in accordance with 902 KAR 100:040, Section 11.
17. Licensed material shall only be used by, or under the supervision of:
- A. Individuals permitted to work as an authorized user, authorized medical physicist, and authorized nuclear pharmacist in accordance with 10 CFR 35.13 and 10 CFR 35.14 (902 KAR 100:072).


