The attached letter refers to the unannounced routine inspection that was conducted by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (USNRC) at your facility in Meridian, Idaho on June 15, 2023 with

continued in-office review through October 31, 2023. Based on the results of this inspection, one apparent violation was identified and is being considered for escalated enforcement. These preliminary findings were discussed with you during the exit briefing on October 31, 2023. Before the USNRC makes a decision, we are providing you an opportunity to either respond in writing or request a predecisional enforcement conference. These options were discussed with you during the exit briefing and are also described in the attached letter.
