SUBJECT: ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF REPLY TO NRC INSPECTION REPORT 030-392942023-001 AND RESCISSION OF NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear John McVey:

On October 18, 2023, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) cited Precision NDT, LLC, for three violations of NRC requirements. The violations involved failures to: (1) receive written consent from the NRC prior to initiating an indirect license transfer; (2) maintain records of doses received by all individuals for whom monitoring was required; and (3) meet certain requirements in 10 CFR Part 37. NRC Inspection Report 030-39294/2023-001 and Notice of Violation (Notice) required you to reply in writing in 30 days (NRC Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. [ML23293A260](#)). In an email sent on November 21, 2023, you provided your reply to the Notice. Your reply is not publicly available because it contains Security-Related Information.

After reviewing the information provided in your reply to the Notice, we have concluded that your completed and proposed corrective actions appear to adequately address the regulatory non-compliance described in the Notice. We will review your implementation of these corrective actions during a future inspection to determine whether full compliance has been restored and whether compliance will be maintained.

With respect to Violation A, after further internal review, the NRC determined that this violation was issued in error and is being rescinded. Specifically, the change of control of Precision NDT, LLC, that was the subject of this violation, occurred prior to the NRC license being issued. The change of control occurred in February 2022, and the NRC license was not issued to Precision NDT, LLC until June 2022. Therefore, the NRC license was not transferred through this change of control; effectively, the application for the license was transferred, so subsequently, this transfer was not in violation of 10 CFR 30.34(b)(1). NRC Inspection Report 030-39294/2023-001 will be re-issued to reflect this change.
