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I have been asked to provide an updated status on the survey activities performed at Picatinny Arsenal under NRC license #SUB-348 for Combat Capabilities Development Command- Armaments Center. The attached documents show the results of scan surveys which were performed at the outdoor areas of the former "dog pound" and former building 22 in 2018. Both areas were found to have higher quantities of soil needing removal than initially expected. At the building 22 area we do not know the depth to which the contaminated soil goes. At the former dog pound area, we ran into problems moving heavy equipment in and out of the location in the woods. Equipment repeatedly sank into the soil and had to be towed out. The site of the former dog pound is in wetlands and therefore a gravel road cannot be put down to facilitate the removal of heavy soil containers. At this time there is no further funding allocated towards remediation of these locations and they are not utilized for any purpose. Armaments Center requests to continue monitoring these locations under NRC license # SUB-348.
