Dear Mr. Taylor:

I am responding to the letter you emailed me on December 18, 2023, regarding Holtec Decommissioning International, LLC's (Holtec) December 6, 2023, Application for Order Consenting to Transfer of Control of License and Approving Conforming License Amendments.<sup>1</sup> You wrote on behalf of three non-profit organizations: Beyond Nuclear, Don't Waste Michigan, and Michigan Safe Energy Future, "request[ing] that the Commission reject consideration and processing of Holtec's application because it is premature, for the reasons set out [in the letter]."

Holtec's submittal is currently under review for acceptance by the NRC staff. If the submission satisfies the acceptance criteria and is accepted for review, a *Federal Register* notice will be published providing instructions for interested parties of an opportunity to request a hearing and to petition for leave to intervene, consistent with 10 C.F.R. 2.309.

Your letter is being treated as a comment on this matter and has been shared with the Commissioners and with the appropriate NRC staff.
