Dear Wilfredo Rivera Febus:

This letter refers to the inspection conducted on October 19, 2023, at your Dorado, Puerto Rico facility, with an in-office review conducted through October 27, 2023. This inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to public health and safety, and to confirm compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selected examination of procedures and representative records, observations of activities, independent and confirmatory radiation surveys, and interviews with personnel. The preliminary inspection findings were discussed with you at the conclusion of the onsite portion of the inspection on October 19, 2023. A final telephonic exit briefing was conducted with you and Rafael Rivera Mercado on November 2, 2023.

Based on the results of this inspection, the NRC has determined that a Severity Level IV violation of NRC requirements occurred. This violation was evaluated in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy. The current Enforcement Policy is included on the NRC's Web site at <https://www.nrc.gov/about-nrc/regulatory/enforcement/enforce-pol.html>. The violation involved NRC security requirements, and thus is cited and described in the non-public Notice of Violation (Notice).

The NRC has concluded that information regarding: (1) the reason for the violation; (2) the corrective actions that have been taken and the results achieved; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved is already adequately addressed on the docket in the enclosed inspection report. Therefore, you are not required to respond to this letter unless the description therein does not accurately reflect your corrective actions or your position. In that case, or if you choose to provide additional information, you should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter and your response, if you choose to provide one, will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room located at NRC Headquarters in Rockville, MD, and from the NRC's document system, the Agencywide Documents Access and
