There are no revisions to New Hampshire Radiological Health Rules He-P 40XX as required by RADS ID 2022-2.

*Although Rats ID 2022-2, which denoted the miscellaneous changes to 10 eCFR 35.13(b)(4), “An individual who is identified as an authorized user, an authorized nuclear pharmacist, authorized medical physicist, or an ophthalmic physicist ...”, no changes were needed in NH He-P 4035 in that individual is required to fulfill all the requirements within the various NH He-P 4035 subparts (equivalent to those in the other subparts of 10 eCFR 35, respectively) before being permitted to use byproduct materials on a NH license amendment as an authorized user, authorized nuclear pharmacist, authorized medical physicist, or an ophthalmic physicist.

We believe the corresponding NH rules to their equivalent NRC regulations satisfy the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) Procedure SA-200.
