SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE FOR ELI LILLY AND COMPANY, NRC LICENSE NO. 13-01133-04

Dear Stanley Hampton:

In Eli Lilly and Company's (your) letter and U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials," dated June 8, 2022, Stanley D. Hampton, MS, Corporate Radiation Safety Officer (you), requested to terminate your NRC License No. 13-01133-04. Your letter including the NRC Form 314 is available electronically from the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML22159A172. The NRC's ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required because this action is categorically excluded under Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Section 51.22(c).

The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the NRC staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions are required with respect to NRC-regulated material. Your facilities are suitable for unrestricted use, and NRC Materials License No. 13-01133-04 is hereby terminated. A copy of the amended license - Amendment No. 14 - is enclosed.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's ADAMS.
