Mr. Vickers:

I have reviewed your response dated January 8, 2024. Upon review, I identified the following areas in which additional information or clarification is needed:

1. Your request omitted the QSA Global, Inc., Model 680A radiography exposure device, which was previously authorized in your license. Please clarify if your company had previously acquired this licensed device. If applicable, please provide documentation of the transfer/disposal of the Model 680A radiographic exposure device.
2. Your request identified that you wish to be provided with authorization to use the QSA Global, Inc. (formerly Technical Operations) Model 770 radiographic source changer.

Please note that U.S. NRC regulates the procedures and standards for approval of packaging and shipping procedures for fissile material and licensed material exceeding a Type A quantity. A list of NRC approved packages is available at the following webpage:

The requested QSA Global, Inc., Model 770 radiographic source changer does not have a Type B Package Certificate. Therefore use of the QSA Global, Inc., Model 770 radiographic source changer may not be practical for use in source exchange as the package may not be transported. Therefore, please clarify if you are in possession of a QSA Global, Inc., Model 770 radiographic source changer and if you would like to be authorized to continue to possess the device for storing sources only.

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
