ADDITIONAL INFORMATION PART 2-2

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission hosted an observation meeting on Microsoft Teams with TRISO-X, LLC (TRISO-X) on January 17, 2024, from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the draft requests for additional information (RAI) for the environmental review in the groundwater resources area. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the RAIs with TRISO-X to ensure they understood the RAIs and provide an opportunity to request clarifications, if needed. The RAIs seek updates to the TRISO-X original application received April 5, 2022 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) ML22101A200), supplemented by letters dated October 13, 2022 (ML22286A144), and November 4, 2022 (ML22308A251), and an environmental report dated September 23, 2022 (ML22266A269). Requests for Additional Information Part 2-2 (RAI2-2) was issued on December 13, 2023 (ML23342A214).

The discussion focused on RAI2-2 GW-1 and RAI2-2 GW-2 which requested information on the local requirements addressing potential karst features on and near the proposed project location. The staff agreed that email communications from the State permitting authorities would be sufficient to address open items addressed in RAI2-2 GW-1. In addition, the staff agreed to review responses to safety RAIs in the hydrology area to determine if those responses would satisfy RAI2-2 GW-2. The staff committed to follow-up with TRISO-X after its review of the responses. A list of participants is provided as an Enclosure.
