SUBJECT: WYOMING PRELIMINARY PROPOSED REVISIONS TO CHAPTERS 1, 6,

AND 9

Dear Kyle Wendtland:

We have reviewed the Wyoming preliminary proposed regulations in Chapters 1, 6, and 9, received by our office on December 14, 2023. This is the second of three planned submissions to add new rules for the regulation of source material recovered from any mineral resource processed primarily for purposes other than its uranium or thorium content. These regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) regulations in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Parts 40 and 71. We discussed our review of the regulations with Brandi O'Brien on February 22, 2024.

As a result of our review, we have 17 comments and 4 editorial suggestions that have been identified in the Enclosure 1. Under our current procedure, a finding that the Wyoming regulations meet the compatibility and health and safety categories of the equivalent NRC regulation may only be made based on a review of the final Wyoming regulations. However, we have determined that if your proposed regulations were adopted, incorporating our comments and without other significant change, they would meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) Procedure SA-200, "Compatibility Categories and Health and Safety Identification for NRC Regulations and Other Program Elements."

We request that when the proposed regulations are adopted and published as final regulations, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review. As requested in NMSS Procedure SA-201, "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight the final changes and provide a copy to Division of Materials Safety, Security, State, and Tribal Programs, NMSS.

The State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet in Enclosure 2 summarizes our knowledge of the status of other Wyoming regulations, as indicated. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies or have any comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet.
