Cabrera Services Inc. (Cabrera) has completed planned field radiological services (surveys and sample collection) performed on behalf of the U.S. Air Force at the Kirtland Air Force Base, Operations/Training (OT-10) Sites.

With regards to the disposition of radioactive materials, investigative derived wastes were containerized and surveyed with control transferred to the facility RSO. Soil samples were packaged and shipped by chain-of-custody to a licensed radioanalytical lab in South Carolina. Exempt quantity instrument check sources were returned to the instrument rental vendor.

Survey findings were communicated to the Facility RSO and other Government representatives throughout the field data collection effort.
