Subject: Vogtle Units 3&4 – Notice of Termination of Agreement Involving Collection of Simulator Data for Human Reliability Analysis

Reference: Agreement Regarding Participation in the Collection of Licensed Operator Simulator Training Data for Human Reliability Analysis, by and between Southern Nuclear Operating Company, Inc. (“SNC”) and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (“NRC”) (the “Collaboration Agreement”), dated January 3, 2018 and executed by SNC on April 13, 2018


Dear Mr. Furstenau:

This letter serves as notice of SNC’s termination of the above referenced Collaboration Agreement between SNC and NRC in accordance with Article 8 thereof. SNC is exercising its right to terminate the Collaboration Agreement for convenience because SNC is no longer pursuing the project underlying the need for the agreement.

The termination will be effective as of February 28, 2020 (the “Termination Date”). Pursuant to Article 8, notwithstanding termination of the Collaboration Agreement, the use restrictions and confidentiality provisions applicable to any information provided by SNC to the NRC survive and remain in effect for a period of ten (10) years following the Termination Date. Accordingly, the NRC shall use and protect any information provided by SNC under the Collaboration Agreement in accordance with those provisions until such time.
