1. Confirm that the name changes, IIA Lab Services, LLC does not constitute a transfer of control of NRC license no. 24-00188-02 as described in NUREG 1556, Volume 15, Revision 1. The guidance is available at <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v15/index.html>.
2. Provide Mr. Werth's radiographer certification.
3. Provide signed and dated Delegation of Authority memo (see attached).
4. Clarify (and provide documentation, if applicable) that the proposed Radiation Safety Officer, Ronald M. Werth, received training and is familiar with the material and use of the instrument calibrators listed on your NRC license no. 24-00188-02.
5. Clarify whether Ronald M. Werth has experience performing functions of an RSO. Specifically, describe the duration of the experience, if applicable, and specific activities performed (e.g., personnel training, review of exposure records, security of material, material disposal, records maintenance, audits of the licensee's radiation protection program, radiation survey meter calibrations, etc.)
