Good morning, Mitchyll:

Thank you for your inquiry regarding your November 17, 2023, request for NRC consent to Change of Control (COC), for the above referenced radioactive materials license.

Currently, no additional information is needed to complete our review of the proposed COC. We are anticipating the removal of the public posting of the proposed transfer, as my Branch Chief, Bob Orlikowski, noted below. Based on information contained in your letter, we understand that the transaction is expected to close on January 2, 2024, prior to the end of the public comment period.

Because the COC is anticipated to occur so soon, and because we understand that the licensee's name and Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) will change, as a result of the transfer, the license will be amended concurrent with NRC issuing its consent for the COC. For NRC to issue the license amendment reflecting that change – together with the COC – we will need confirmation that the transaction has occurred.

To complete our review, please submit a signed and dated letter, confirming completion of the transaction, upon completion of the transfer. Please include a certificate, court order, or other document, to demonstrate that the transfer is complete. Please note that documentation demonstrating the completed transaction need not be the full contract, or detailed description of the changes. A 1–2-page document or certificate should be sufficient.

In the alternative to providing the information confirming the completed COC, should the transaction not be complete within 28 days, please provide a signed and dated letter indicating the revised anticipated date by which the transaction will be completed.

Your written response to this request is needed to complete our review.

Please provide a response via a signed and dated letter within 28 days (on or before January 19, 2024). If you are unable to provide a response before then, please provide a signed and dated letter by that date indicating the date by which you will be able to provide a written response to the items outlined in this request. For quickest processing, please submit your response as a pdf file attached to an email message. You may also submit a response via fax or via regular mail. If you have any questions regarding this message, please do not hesitate to reach out to me by phone or email.
