SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE FOR WSP USA, INC.,
U.S. NRC MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 29-28576-01

Dear Mr. Bemrich:

In letter dated February 5, 2024, you notified the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of a request to terminate U.S. NRC Materials License No. 29-28576-01. Your letter is available electronically from the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML24038A048.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required because this action is categorically excluded under Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) Section 51.22(c).

In your letter dated February 5, 2024, you requested the transfer of facilities at 400 136th Ave., Bldg. 100, Ste. B, Holland, Michigan and 15851 S. U.S. 27, Ste. 50, Lansing, Michigan, to another NRC licensee — WSP USA Environment & Infrastructure, Inc., U.S. NRC Materials License No. 02-29087-01. In support of your request, you provided transfer records and associated leak test results.

Documentation of the transfer of radioactive materials, including associated leak test reports were reviewed. Based on this review, all licensable radioactive material at 400 136th Ave., Bldg. 100, Ste. B, Holland, Michigan and 15851 S. U.S. 27, Ste. 50, Lansing, Michigan, has been transferred from WSP USA, Inc., U.S. NRC Materials License No. 29-28576-01, to WSP USA Environment & Infrastructure, Inc., U.S. NRC Materials License No. 02-29087-01. Further, the results of the submitted leak test reports demonstrate that there is no residual radioactive material attributable to your licensed activities exceeding current U.S. NRC criteria.

Based on this conclusion, no further remediation or actions with respect to U.S. NRC-regulated material are required on the part of WSP USA, Inc. The U.S. NRC understands that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the 400 136th Ave., Bldg. 100, Ste. B, Holland, Michigan and 15851 S. U.S. 27, Ste. 50, Lansing, Michigan, facilities have been transferred to and will be maintained by WSP USA Environment & Infrastructure, Inc., U.S. NRC License No. 02-29087-01.

Accordingly, U.S. NRC Materials License No. 29-28576-01 is hereby terminated. A copy of the amended license—Amendment No. 18—is enclosed.
