**SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 53-17839-01**

By letter dated March 1, 2024, you informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive materials license. The NRC Form 314 dated March 1, 2024, stated that all radioactive material had been either disposed or transferred to another licensed entity.

The supporting documentation to the NRC Form 314 provided a copy of the latest leak test results. The leak test results document that there was no evidence of leakage of radioactive material from the sealed sources. The supporting documentation to the NRC Form 314 also stated that the licensee possessed radioactive materials with radioactive decay half-lives of less than 120 days. A review of the historical file supported that, other than the sealed sources identified in the letter, only short lived radioactive materials were possessed by the licensee.

The NRC staff has reviewed the supporting documentation to your NRC Form 314. Based on the documentation submitted and a review of your historical file, the staff concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facility and the facility located at 128 Lehua Street Wahiawa, Hawaii 96786, is suitable for unrestricted use in accordance with 10 CFR 20.1402, "Radiological Criteria for Unrestricted Use." Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required.

Please find enclosed Amendment No. 35 to License No. 53-17839-01 authorizing your license termination. An environmental assessment for this action is not required since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(i) and 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(ii).
