

MATERIALS LICENSE

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-438), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 39, 40, 70 and 71, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 183 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.

CONDITIONS

- 10. Licensed material shall be used or stored at the licensee's facilities located at: Hospital Menonita Ponce, Puerto Rico Highway 506, Coto Laurel, Ponce, Puerto Rico, 00780
- 11. The Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) for this license is Carmelo Peréz.
- 12. Licensed material shall only be used by, or under the supervision of:
 - A. Individuals permitted to work as authorized users in accordance with 10 CFR 35.13 and 10 CFR 35.14.
 - B. The following individuals are authorized users for the material and medical uses as indicated:

This license condition applies only to those statements, representations, and procedures that are required to be submitted in accordance with the regulations. Additionally, this license condition does not limit the licensee's ability to make changes to the radiation protection program as provided for in 10 CFR 35.26. The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern unless the statements, representations, and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence impose on the licensee requirements that are more restrictive than or in addition to the regulations.
