SUBJECT: PENNSYLVANIA LICENSE CONDITION REVIEW

Dear Dwight Shearer:

We have reviewed the Pennsylvania license condition requirements used on their radioactive materials licenses, received by our office on February 12, 2024. These requirements were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules 37.57, 30.50, 31.5, 35.65 and 35.2067 as identified in the enclosed State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. We discussed our review of the legally binding requirements with you on June 10, 2024.


As a result of our review, we have five comments that have been identified in Enclosure 1. We have determined that if these requirements are revised, incorporating our comments and without other significant change, they would meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) Procedure SA-200, "Compatibility Categories and Health and Safety Identification for NRC Regulations and Other Program Elements."

We request that when you revise your legally binding requirements to address our comments, a copy of the revised legally binding requirements be provided to us for review. As requested in NMSS Procedure SA-201, "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight the location of any changes made and provide a copy to' Division of Materials Safety, Security, State, and Tribal Programs, NMSS.

The SRS Data Sheet in Enclosure 2 summarizes our knowledge of the status of other Pennsylvania regulations, as indicated. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies or have any comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet. COMPATIBILITY COMMENTS ON PENNSYLVANIA LEGALLY BINDING REQUIREMENTS
