**SUBJECT: DUPONT SPECIALTY PRODUCTS USA, LLC, REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION, MAIL CONTROL NO. 637691**

Dear Greg Westbrook:

This is in reference to your letter dated March 22, 2024, with the letter from TJC, LP dated March 22, 2024, in response to our Request for Additional Information dated December 28, 2023. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information regarding the indirect transfer of control of the license from DuPont Specialty Products USA, LLC (DuPont) to TJC, LP, through the acquisition of 80.1% of its ownership by The Resolute Fund VI, LP, a private equity fund managed by TJC, LP.

1. Because TJC, LP is not affiliated with any other companies that hold a radioactive materials license from the NRC or an Agreement State, a pre-licensing visit with representatives of TJC, LP is required. Please provide names and contact information of individuals who should be involved in the pre-licensing meeting by letter or electronic mail so that a date for this meeting can be arranged.
2. TJC, LP needs to confirm, or state any changes made, that TJC, LP
  - a. will not change the radiation safety officer listed in the NRC license;
  - b. will not change the personnel involved in licensed activities;
  - c. will not change the locations, facilities, and equipment authorized in the NRC license;
  - d. will not change the radiation safety program authorized in the NRC license;
  - e. will keep regulatory required surveillance records and decommissioning records; and
  - f. Will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. A response may be provided as a pdf copy of a letter signed by management, attached to electronic mail directly to [Elizabeth.Ullrich@nrc.gov](mailto:Elizabeth.Ullrich@nrc.gov) . While it is allowable, please refrain from submitting proprietary information in support of a license unless necessary. Keep in mind that all NRC licenses are considered to be in the public domain, and therefore may be viewed by any member of the public who requests to see them.
