I. SECY-24-0010 – MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENA IN MISSOURI STATE
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY INVESTIGATION

The Commission¹ approved a Memorandum and Order addressing a motion submitted by the Missouri Department of Public Safety (DPS) to quash or modify a subpoena issued by the NRC's Office of Investigations. DPS raises various objections to the subpoena's requests, including that they are overbroad, overly burdensome, not relevant, not within the NRC's regulatory authority, and barred from disclosure under Missouri law.

The Memorandum and Order denies DPS's motion to quash or modify the subpoena.
