**SUBJECT: Reply to a Notice of Violation**

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing this letter in response to the notice of violation received by Connecticut State Community College – Gateway, from the NRC. According to the violation, Connecticut State Community College – Gateway failed to comply with NRC Requirement 10 CFR 30.34 (b) (1):

**10 CFR 30.34(b)(1) requires that no license issued or granted pursuant to the regulations in this part and parts 31 through 36, and 39 nor any right under a license shall be transferred, assigned or in any manner disposed of, either voluntarily or involuntarily, directly or indirectly, through transfer of control of any license to any person, unless the Commission shall, after securing full information, find that the transfer is in accordance with the provisions of the Act and shall give its consent in writing.**

As stated in the letter, I reached out to the NRC on July 24, 2023, via email to find out how to request approval for an amendment for a name change from Gateway Community College to Connecticut State Community College – Gateway. I realize that this was after the date of the college merger which took place on July 1, 2023, but from my initial email inquiry on July 24, 2023, I had been working diligently to get the request completed. Once I was able to get final signatures, and additional information, I immediately submitted the final request on September 21, 2023. Since then, we received notification on March 11, 2024, that our name change was accepted. As of today, we are in full compliance with the NRC regulations and requirements and I am confident that there will be no further violations of the NRC requirements moving forward.

I thank you for the opportunity to respond to this notice of violation and look forward to working with the NRC in the future.
