**DOMINION ENERGY NUCLEAR CONNECTICUT, INC.**  
**MILLSTONE POWER STATION UNITS 2 AND 3**  
**PRE-DECISIONAL REPLY TO EA-23-144**

On April 25, 2024, Dominion Energy Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. (DENC) received Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Special Inspection Report 05000336/2024440 and 05000423/2024440 (Reference 1) documenting the preliminary significance determination of a finding and the associated apparent violation (AV) 05000336,05000423/2024440-01 (EA-23-144). The Special Inspection Report states that the NRC assessed the significance of the finding using the "Baseline Security Significance Determination Process for Power Reactors" and readily available information. The Special Inspection Report indicated that the associated AV is being considered for escalated enforcement action in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy.

Consistent with the instructions provided in the Special Inspection Report, this letter provides notification to the NRC that DENC accepts the finding(s) and the AV(s). DENC; (1) does not request a regulatory or pre-decisional conference related to EA-23-144, and (2) does not plan to provide a written response related to the significance of the finding or characterization of the AV in EA-23-144 prior to the NRC making a final determination for the finding and apparent violation.

In accordance with the instructions in Reference 1, DENC has verbally notified Daniel Schroeder of our intentions.
