It was brought to our attention that there was an administrative error in your current NRC materials license, License No. 24-15159-01. Specifically, the authorization for 10 CFR 35.300 materials for John Bedwinek, M.D. was inadvertently deleted in the license when we updated his authorization in our Web-based Licensing (WBL) system. Enclosed is the corrected copy for Amendment No. 86.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. NRC Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we may provide appropriate corrections and answers.
