SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT 030-35114/2023-004; AND NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Matthew Kim:

This letter refers to the unannounced inspection that was performed on August 31, 2023, at your facility in Anchorage, Alaska, with continued in-office review through May 3, 2024. The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to public health and safety, to confirm compliance with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) rules, regulations, and with the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selected examination of procedures and representative records, observation of licensed activities, independent radiation measurements, and interviews with personnel. The preliminary inspection findings were discussed with Ian Moreau, Technology Manager, at the conclusion of the onsite portion of the inspection on August 31, 2023. A final telephonic exit briefing was conducted with Jeremy Dunning, site Radiation Safety Officer, on June 11, 2024.

Based on the results of this inspection, the NRC has determined that one Severity Level IV violation of NRC requirements occurred. The violation was evaluated in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy which can be found at the NRC's Web site at <https://www.nrc.gov/about-nrc/regulatory/enforcement/enforce-pol.html>.

The violation is being cited in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice) because it was identified by the NRC during the inspection. The violation involved NRC security requirements, and thus is cited and described in the Notice, which is non-public.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. The guidance in NRC Information Notice 96-28, "Suggested Guidance Relating to Development and Implementation of Corrective Action," may be helpful in preparing your response. Information regarding the reasons for each violation, the corrective actions taken and planned to correct the violations and prevent recurrence, and the date when full compliance will be (was) achieved should be addressed. 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
determine whether further enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements.
