The Nuclear Regulatory Commission recently published a Federal Register Notice announcing our intent to submit an information collection request to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for 10 CFR Part 140, "Financial Protection Requirements and Indemnity Agreements". As a potential respondent to this information collection, we are interested in your feedback. Specifically, we are seeking input on the following questions by August 19, 2024:

2. Is the estimate of the burden of the information collection accurate? Please explain your answer.
3. Is there a way to enhance the quality, utility, and clarity of the information to be collected?
4. How can the burden of the information collection on respondents be minimized, including the use of automated collection techniques or other forms of information technology?
