
This letter is a request for an amendment to our Material Licenses 13-09810-01 and SNM-995. We are requesting that John Stamm be removed from the license as Radiation Safety Officer and Mark Davis be named as the new, temporary Radiation Safety Officer.

Dr. Mark Davis was appointed as Radiation Safety Officer for the University of Evansville, April 25, 2003 and was RSO until 2012 when Dr. John Stamm was appointed RSO. Mark Davis has served as deputy RSO from that point in 2012 until present.


Training and experience of Mark Davis:
