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PART I.D -- COMMENTS

Upon our receipt of your request on February 28, 2024, we tasked the Office of the Executive Director for Operations [OEDO] to search for, and provide disclosure recommendations as to, the audio recordings of the two Town Hall meetings.

After careful consideration, the NRC is withholding the audio recordings in their entirety. The November 9, 2022 and September 20, 2023 Town Hall Meetings, and by extension the recordings of these meetings, were wholly internal, intraagency, predecisional dialogues related to agency personnel matters. Based upon the nature of these meetings, the requested records are being withheld, in full, in accordance with FOIA exemptions (b)(2) and (b)(5). Release of these records would be premature as the personnel matters remain unresolved and would cause harm by providing the public with erroneous and misleading information. Additionally, disclosure of the information in these recordings would inhibit and chill open communications and future exchanges of information among agency personnel and management, as well as discourage candid and effective discussions aimed at aiding in the agency's decision-making. Finally, with respect to the November 9th audio recording, there are portions of the recording that are also being withheld under the attorney-client privilege, which is subsumed within exemption (b)(5), and exemption (b)(6).
