DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY RADIATION SAFETY OFFICER

The Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) for this institution is a full-time position. Christopher Harvey has been appointed as the RSO and is responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiation and radioactive materials under NRC license numbers 13-02752-03 and 13-02752-08. Mr. Harvey's responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

1. Managing the radiation protection program,
2. Identifying radiation protection problems,
3. Initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions,
4. Verifying implementation of correction actions,
5. Stopping unsafe activities,
6. Ensuring compliance with regulations and license conditions,
7. Directing and supervising other members of the radiation safety staff to ensure the safe use of radiation and radioactive materials, and
8. Applying for and signing appropriate amendments to the NRC licenses.

Mr. Harvey is hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of byproduct material by individuals who do not meet the necessary requirements and also shutting down operations when justified for radiation safety purposes. This authority extends to cover the hospitals and other clinical areas covered by this license through written agreements with those entities. This authority becomes effective as of July 3, 2024.

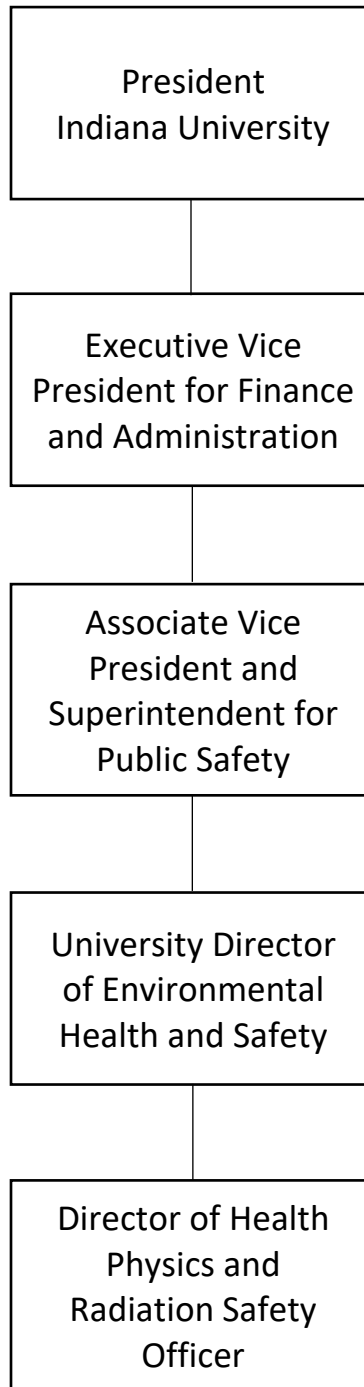
