Medical Licensing,

Saint Mary's Hospital requests that the following changes be made to Radioactive Materials License No. 06-00679-01:

• Removal of License Condition 10.C. - Saint Mary's Hospital Naugatuck Valley Surgery Center (NVSC), located at 160 Robbins Street, Waterbury, CT no longer uses radioactive material for 35.200 studies. NVSC performed sentinel node studies at the location through calendar year 2022. No 35.200 studies have been performed at the location since 2022. The only sealed source utilized at that location was a 0.4 microCurie Cs-137 rod source used for well counter quality control. That source has been returned to the main hospital facility.
