Secretary's Meeting Report

5:00 p. m.

The Chairman called me to his office to inform me that Mr. Harold Price, Director of Regulation, had some time ago told him of his contemplated retirement in the summer of this year and that he had deferred his retirement in order to assist the Commission in the resolution of and response to the institutional implications of the U. S. Court of Appeals (District of Columbia Circuit) Decision on Calvert Cliffs. Mr. Price had suggested that in light of his pending plans for retirement, the Commissioners might wish to consider a replacement for the position of Director of Regulation.

Today, in an informal session of the Commission from 11:30 a. m. to 3:30 p. m., the Commission agreed to accept Mr. Price's resignation and after consideration of a number of candidates for the post, had agreed to offer Mr. Manning Muntzing, General Attorney for Chesapeake and Potomac of Maryland, the position of Director of Regulation, effective upon its vacancy.
