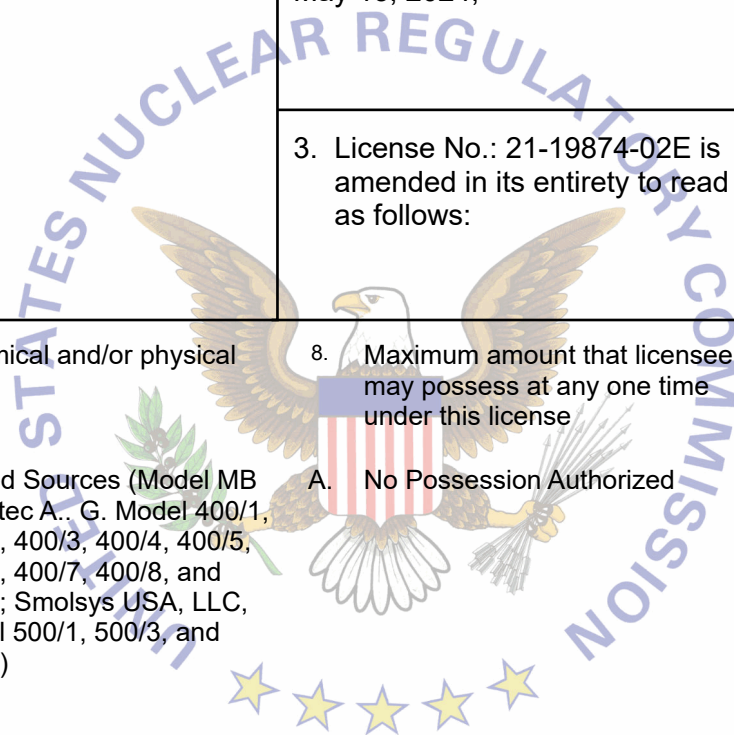


**MATERIALS LICENSE**

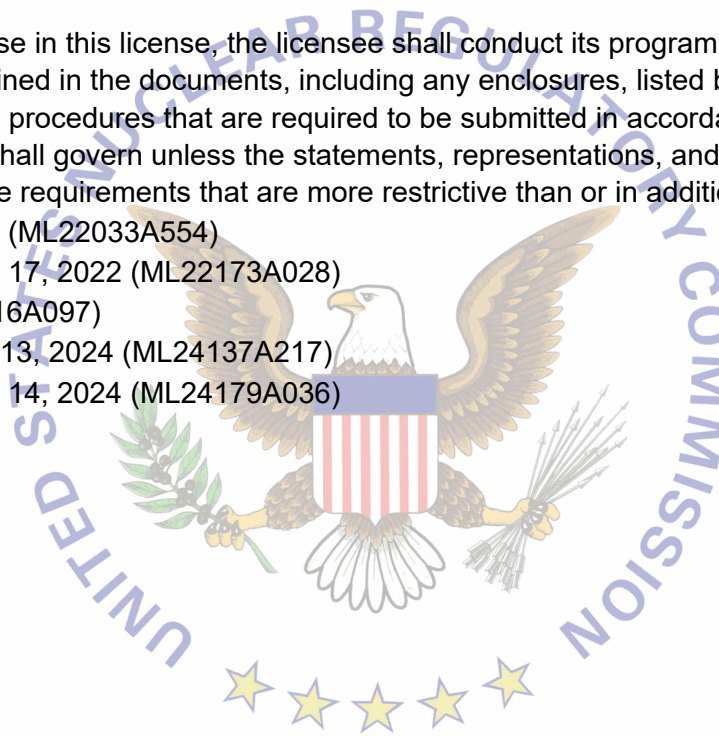
