RE: Notification of Future Change of Control – Radioactive Material License 37-17717-02

Dear Sir/Madame:

I am writing to inform the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission - Region I of TranSystem Corporation d/b/a Transystems Corporation Consultants Transystems intention to apply for authorization for change of control for Radioactive Materials License 37-17717-02. This change is scheduled to happen in January of 2025.

On 8-5-2024, Transystems Corporation signed an agreement with Gannett Fleming to merge the two Companies. These Companies will consolidate into one in January 2025. Prior to this consolidation, both companies will operate independently with no modification to organization structure, financial responsibility, tax ID, etc. There will be no name change, transfer of control or modification to gauge inventory/sources, storage location(s), personnel, etc. until the consolidation happens.

In the upcoming months, Transystems Corporation and Gannett Fleming will develop a new brand for the consolidated business, as well as outline a new organizational structure and assign financial responsibilities. Once these details are known, we will submit the required documentation pursuant to Regulations 10 CFR 30, 10 CFR 40 and 10 CFR 70, as well as Nureg 1556 Volume 15 rev 1.
