This is in reference to your application dated August 1, 2024, requesting to renew NRC License No. 47-18080-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Your application dated August 1, 2024 appears to be requested by Kevin Stalnaker, Chief Administrative Officer. We do not have any record of this individual having the delegation of authority to make legally binding commitments on behalf of your license. Our records currently indicate that Joe Second, Senior Director of Operation is the primary contact for this license. Please indicate if this should be changed to Kevin Stalnaker. If so, please provide contact information for this individual including email address, telephone number, and fax number.
2. Item 9, Facility Diagram
 - a. In your application dated August 1, 2024, you provided a facility diagram that indicated the doors within the facility. However, you did not indicate which doors are access controlled. Please identify which doors in your facility are access controlled in your facility diagram.
 - b. Additionally, in your application dated August 1, 2024, you provided diagrams of rooms where byproduct materials are prepared, used, and stored. None of the rooms were labelled indicating the location of each room within your facility. Please include the location and room numbers for these rooms for all areas where byproduct materials are prepared, used, and stored. The direction of north should be indicated.
