The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is issuing a final rule, "Renewing Nuclear Power Plant Operating Licenses – Environmental Review," to amend its environmental protection regulations by updating the Commission's 2013 findings on the environmental effect of renewing the operating license of a nuclear power plant. The final rule will be published in the *Federal Register* on or about August 2, 2024.

In support of this final rule, the NRC is also issuing Revision 2 to NUREG-1437, "Generic Environmental Impact Statement for License Renewal of Nuclear Plants" (LR GEIS). The final revised LR GEIS provides the technical basis for the rule. On or about August 2nd, the final revised LR GEIS will be available from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) as ML24087A133. Staff guidance (NUREG-1555, Supplement 1, Revision 2) and guidance for applicants (Regulatory Guide 4.2, Supplement 1, Revision 2) will be available as ML23201A227 and ML23201A144, respectively. ADAMS is accessible from the NRC's website at <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>. These documents will also be accessible at <https://www.nrc.gov/reactors/operating/licensing/renewal/sled.html>.

The final revised LR GEIS was submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency via e-NEPA, and the final revised LR GEIS, final rule, and associated final guidance documents are being distributed to interested Federal, State, Tribal, and local agencies, industry organizations, interest groups, and members of the public via the above methods.
